The increase in the use of mobile devices has opened the door for a plethora of mobile security risks.

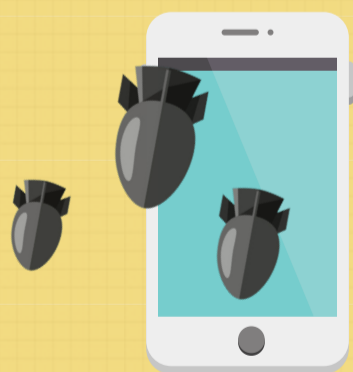
If your phone is unguarded or has a predictable password, then anyone who steals your phone can have easy access to your personal and financial data saved on the device.
