

Most Common Social Engineering Attacks



Social engineering is the term used for range of malicious activities which uses psychological manipulation to trick users into making security mistakes or giving away sensitive information.

Baiting

Attack using false promises to pique victim's greed or interest.

Phishing

Attack aims at creating a sense of urgency, curiosity or fear in victims to either open infected attachments or to click on links to malicious websites.

Spear Phishing

Targeted attacks using characteristics, job positions, and other information specific to the victim.

Pretexting

Attacker pretending to need sensitive information to perform critical task.

Scareware

Attack using fictitious threats and alarms to prompt user to install malicious software.
